Virginia State University conducted its 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Athletic Scholarship Golf Tournament at Dogwood, Trace Golf Course in Petersburg, Virginia. C3R supports again this year, as in previous years, to what we consider to be a worthy cause in supporting the increase in scholarships for athletes as well as the investment into America's youth. This Golf Tournament, which occurs during Alumni Weekend, is an opportunity for Alumni and friends of the university to compete, fellowship, and build upon a legacy and a valuable institution of higher education.

In the article, *The Best 50 Colleges For African Americans*, featured in the May 2016 issue of Essence Magazine, Virginia State University ranked 20<sup>th</sup> based upon three criterion: representation which means African Americans must constitute at least 5% of the student body; affordability which is calculated based on an average loan debt after subtracting student aid; and postgrad earnings which combines both graduation rates with an analysis of earnings. In the same survey, HBCUs accounted for 15 of the Top 50 schools. Most significantly, all of the Top 10 schools for STEM degrees for African American students are HBCUs. Our minority colleges and universities continue to be a major contributor to America's solution to economic well-being, the STEM evolution, and domestic and global leadership.

C3R entered five teams all lead by Alumni from Virginia State University, and supported the tournament as a Hole Sponsor. C3R encourages other businesses,
